Programme Overview

Introduction

Leaderonomics Youth in partnership with ECM Libra Foundation and EPSOM College in Malaysia have provided 98 youths aged between 12-17 years old from all over Malaysia the opportunity to experience the SPARK Leadership Programme which was conducted on 14-23 December 2014 (see attachment for Programme Outline) in EPSOM College in Malaysia.

The objectives of the programme are as follows:

- i. To help participants discover their leadership potential
- ii. To provide essential leadership tools and motivate participants to make a difference in their communities
- iii. To encourage unity by building a deeper understanding between cultures and a sense of appreciation for the multicultural society in Malaysia

To achieve these objectives, we have outlined a few specially designed sessions to achieve the aforementioned objectives. Examples of the sessions are as follows:

1. Lead Challenge

Being one of the highlights of camp, Lead Challenge empowered five teams to create and execute sustainable plans of lasting impact for various community groups. Through this, participants learned how to plan a project, delegate tasks, manage finances, and teamwork. The community groups involved are:

- a) DropZone - A Youth Inspiration Centre for youth around PJ Old Town to come and explore their potential.
- b) Mentari Project - A voluntary educational tuition centre run by volunteers for the underprivileged kids in Desa Mentari.
- c) New Life Care Centre – A centre for orphans and children from dysfunctional families where parents are often single and poor.
- d) Nanthisar Home - A home for single mums, orphans and kids with single parents.
- e) Somali Refugees - A community of Somali refugees located in Puchong.

2. Project Management

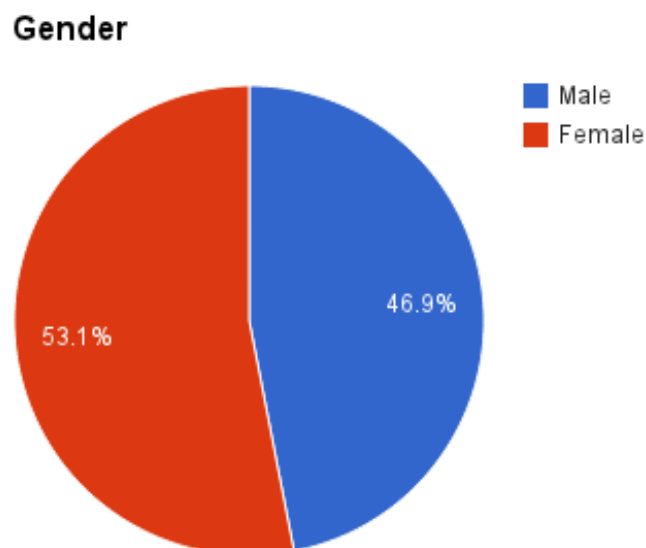
Participants are provided with the necessary tools to plan their project including SMART Goals, progress tracking and basic financial planning and budget reporting.

3. Hari Malaysia

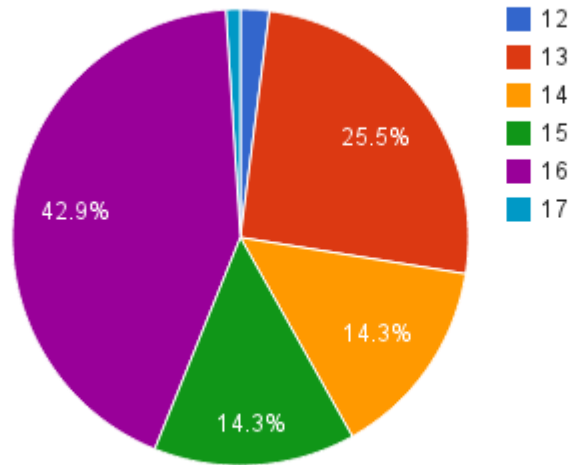
Participants discover the rich cultures and learn to appreciate and embrace the diversity the country has to offer. Participants get to share their unique cultures and experience the differences through sharing and games.

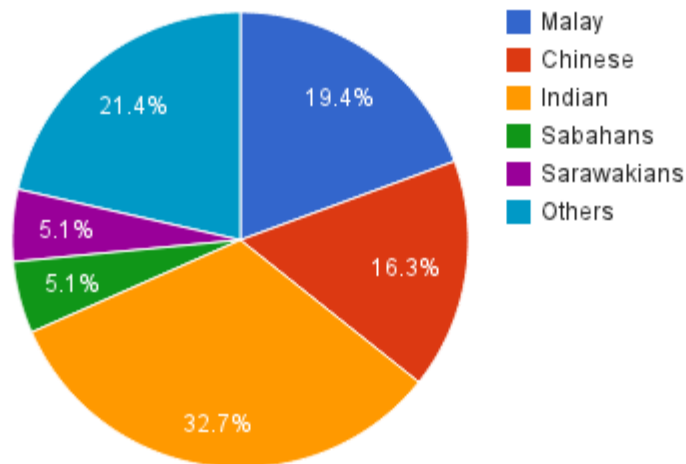

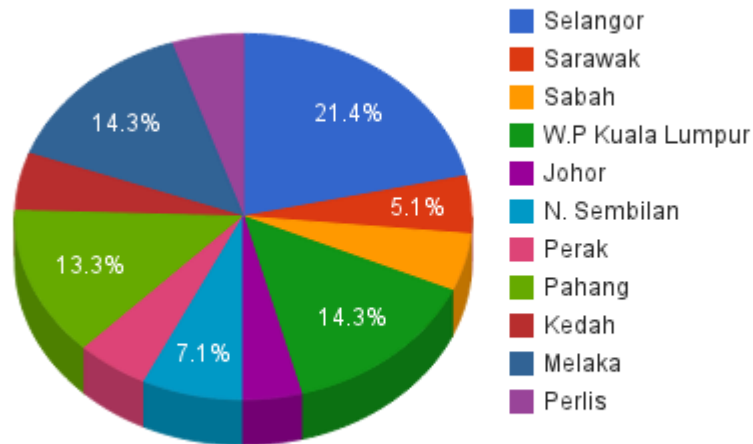

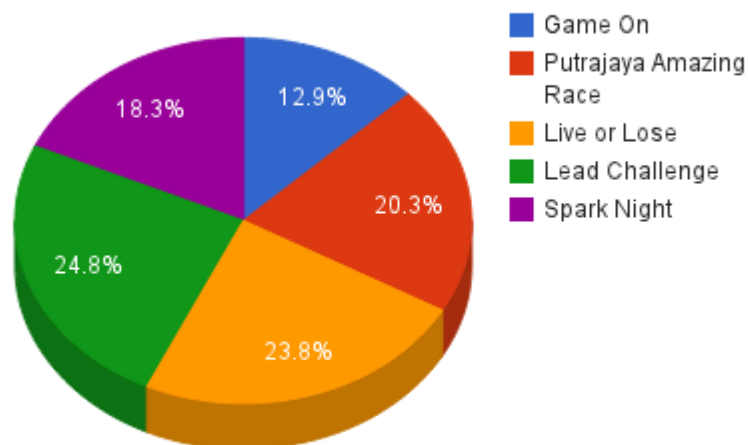


Participants Based on States

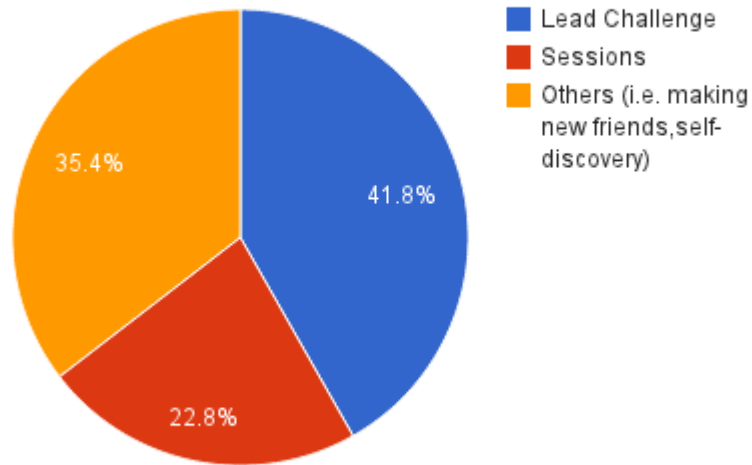


Overview of Participants' Experience

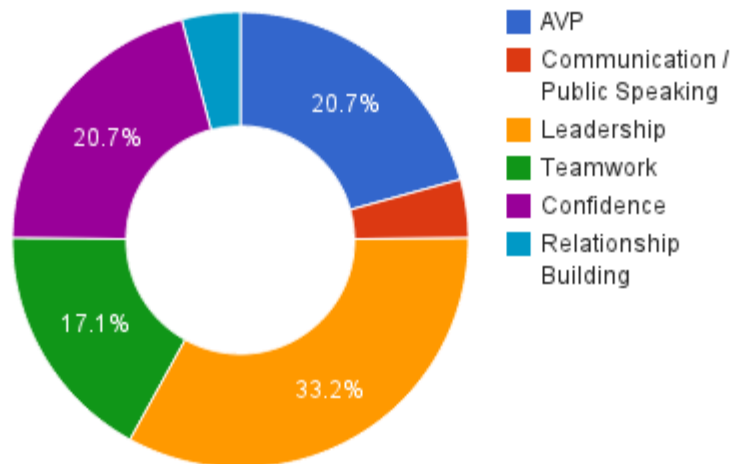
